## TOURNAMENT RULES

## All games will be played under 2020 FIBA Rules except where modified below:

- All games will commence at the advertised times. No team shall take the court with less than four (4) players. For each minute that a team is late, their opponent will be awarded (1) point for up to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes, after which the match will be forfeited.
- Any team which withdraws from the tournament after the completion of the draw will forfeit that team's entry fee.
- Up to and including Under 12 age groups will use a size 5 match ball. Under 14 age groups will use a size 6 match ball. Under 16 and 19 Boys will use a size 7 match ball, and Under 16 and 19 Girls will use a size 6 match ball.
- The best warm up ball will be used as the game ball.
- Three (3) point shots will only count in Under 14, 16 and 19 age groups.
- Tournament officials may report any participant to Tournament Executives who will convene the appropriate tribunal.
- The Tournament Executives decision shall be final in all matters.
- No player shall take the court unless wearing the correct uniform.
- A player must play in two (2) first round games to qualify to play in any finals.
- A maximum of 12 players can register per squad for the overall tournament weekend, with a maximum of 10 players being eligible to register for each individual game. Qualifying rules as stated above apply regardless of how many players are registered per side.
- Please note only 10 trophies will be presented to each team competing in the Grand Final.
- Players can only play for one (1) team during the tournament. If they play in a second team, that game will be deemed a forfeit.
- We have ZERO TOLERANCE for poor behaviour. The penalty for technical fouls will be two shots and side possession. The sin bin will be used.
- The mercy rule will apply to all U10s, U12s and U14s games where a team is leading by 20pts or more. The leading team must play defence within the 3 pt line. The same rule applies to U16s and U19s games where the score margin is 30 pts or more. Failure to comply will result in a bench Technical.


## TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES

- All teams must have a set of alternate coloured tops for use in the event of a clash of colours with an opposing team. The team listed $1^{\text {st }}$ on the digital scoring has uniform preference.
- Uniforms must bear legal numbers as per FIBA rules.
- Each team must provide a competent Scorer/Timekeeper for their games ( $16 \mathrm{yo}+$ ) The team listed $1^{\text {st }}$ on the digital scoring will be the Timekeeper.
- Individual players details must be entered online using the unique team link provided at the point of team registration. Players who do not appear on the PlayHQ Digital Scoring system are ineligible to play.


## ALL PLAYERS \& COACHING STAFF MUST BE REGISTERED NO LATER THAN 9pm on WEDNESDAY 6 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ DECEMBER 2023

- If an injury occurs to a player, then an injury report must be recorded on the PlayHQ Digital Scoring system for insurance records. Basketball Moe Inc. denies any liability for any injuries incurred.
- Teams are to provide their own warm-up balls. Thes best warm up ball deemed by the referee will be used as the game ball.
- Game forfeit fee will be $\$ 100.00$.
- Protests must be lodged in writing to the Tournament Director (squad@basketballmoe.com.au) with a bond of $\$ 200.00$, which is redeemable if upheld.
- First Aid at Latrobe Leisure Moe/Newborough is located at the squash courts. This is located in the hallway which links reception and court 3+4. At Gippsland Regional Indoor Sports Stadium (GRISS) first aid will be located within the foyer. Teams are responsible for their own first aid requirements at Latrobe Leisure Morwell.


## GAME POINTS

Win = 3 points | Loss = 1 point $\mid$ Draw = 2 points $\mid$ Forfeit $=0$ points

## Ties for position will be decided as follows:

2-way-tie: result of game played between the two teams concerned. If these teams did not meet, the position will be decided on overall percentage.

3-way-tie: percentage of games between teams involved providing they all played one another, or otherwise on overall percentage. The same applies for ties involving more than 3 teams.

In any situation not covered above, the position will be determined at the discretion of Tournament Executives.

## CHRIS PEARCE MVP AWARD

Referees are asked by Moe Basketball Inc. to nominate a player 'best on court' during each Grand Final. This player will be awarded the Chris Pearce MVP Medal. We use this medal to honour and remember the contribution Chris made to our basketball community.

## TIMING RULES

## Round Games:

- Games will be played in $2 \times 20$ minute halves.
- Half time duration is two (2) minutes.
- Each team will be permitted two time-outs per half. The clock will not stop for time-outs or whistles.
- Time-outs are not permitted in the last one minute of the $1^{\text {st }}$ half and last three minutes of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ half.
- No substitutions will be allowed during the last one (1) minute of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ half except for compulsory substitutions including injuries where the clock will stop for the substitution to take place.


## Semi Finals:

- Time-outs will be permitted at anytime during the game (two per team, per half).
- The clock will be stopped on all whistles and time-outs in the last one minute of the $1^{\text {st }}$ half and last three minutes of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ half.


## Grand Finals:

- The clock will be stopped for all time-outs (two per team, per half).
- The clock will be stopped on all whistles in the last one minute of the $1^{\text {st }}$ half and last three minutes of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ half.

In the case of drawn games, an extra period of 3 minutes will be played. The clock will be stopped on all whistles in the extra time period. Each team will be allowed 1 time-out for every extra period of overtime. If the game is drawn at the end of the overtime period, an additional 3 minute period will be played. Should a $3^{\text {rd }}$ period of extra time be required, the first team to score during that period will be declared the outright winner.
